
In 2002, a major program was initiated in St Petersburg for the reform of the public transport sector. On the request of the Transport Committee, CONTRANS was commissioned to take part in the process as special advisors. Plans and programs were reviewed and commented upon and Swedish and international experiences were demonstrated during seminars and study tours.

Public Transport Authority

Particular focus was laid on the introduction of a Public Transport Authority (Transport Organiser Service) with the responsibility to plan and monitor a route network to be operated by both the public and the private sector. Experiences from Scandinavia were of a special interest and the final design was to a large extent modelled on these.

Public tendering

The new organisation of the public transport sector was based on the use of public tendering for services to be provided by the private sector. The first tender was issued in September 2005.
